SIGNIFICANT INCIDENTS

Tanker Targeted in Multiple attacks near Bab El Mandeb

On 08 Aug 24, the Liberia-flagged crude oil tanker *DELTA BLUE* came under multiple attacks in the Bab El Mandeb Strait about 45 nm South of Al Mukha, Yemen. The first assault involved a rocket-propelled grenade (RPG) fired from a skiff, which detonated near the vessel. Over the next 16 hours, the vessel's master reported three additional attacks:

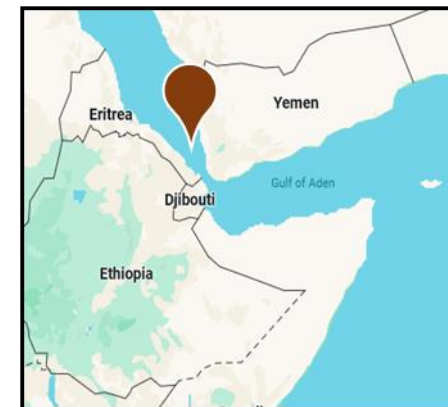
- A missile detonated in close proximity to the tanker.
- An Uncrewed Surface Vessel (USV) attempted to strike, but the Ship's Armed Security Team (AST) successfully engaged it, causing the USV to explode at a safe distance.
- A missile ditched near the vessel.
- The crew and vessel were safe.

Vessel Targeted in Multiple attacks Off Al Hudaydah, Yemen

On 13 Aug 24, *ON PHOENIX* encountered a series of hostile incidents approximately 97 nm NW of Al Hudaydah, Yemen. The first incident involved an explosion close to the vessel. Shortly after, a small craft was observed behaving suspiciously, signaling with flashing lights towards the vessel. This was followed by a second explosion, again in close proximity to the vessel. Despite these aggressive actions, the vessel sustained no damage, and there were no reported injuries among the crew.

Smuggling of 16 Containers of Cigarettes foiled – Indonesia

On 08 Aug 24, the Indonesia Custom authorities seized 16 containers of cigarettes at the Tanjung Perak Port Depot. Approximately 73,000,000 illegal cigarettes were intended for distribution in Indonesia, posing a potential state loss of IDR 217 billion (USD 13,621,090). The perpetrators, believed to be foreign nationals, employed a scheme to ship these illegal cigarettes to Surabaya without a clear destination.

Fire Onboard Passenger Vessel undergoing repairs - Indonesia

On 11 Aug 24, the Indonesia flagged passenger vessel KM Kirana 1 caught fire in the waters of Tanjung Emas Port, Semarang, Indonesia. All 52 individuals, including 21 crew, 24 vendors, and seven technicians, were safely rescued after they jumped into the sea to escape the flames. The fire incident triggered by an explosion on the ship's deck, is still under investigation by the authorities.
